## Epsom Historical Center Update

Last October we were waiting on the electrical work to be completed, with the new track lighting already installed and new fixtures downstairs were installed and were awaiting covers. The new electrical work left many holes in the walls and ceilings were old wiring and fixtures were removed and new wiring added. Once the holes were filled, the upstairs was to be painted and the work of setting up a museum upstairs would commence. Then the furnace incident changed all that.

The last week of January 2010, the clean-up began, then several walls and the entire ceiling downstairs were removed. Construction began in February with the following:

Insulating the downstairs ceiling and a new ceiling added with new vents to keep the pipes from freezing, new heating vents and new light fixtures and covers, new paint.

The new walls were added and the entire downstairs painted. The trustees had the old rear sliding door replaced with a new hard wood door, with the rear wall refinished and painted.

New carpeting was added on the stairs with some new trim on the stairwell.

The bathroom and old office got new flooring.

The holes in the walls and ceilings upstairs were filled and the entire upstairs re-painted.

Early in March there was a final cleaning, the old interior double doors hung, and the Historical Association moved back in. The computers were returned, the front entrance curtain treatments have been hung, along with several historical prints and items upstairs. The old display cases from the new library were moved into the old stack room. New outlets were installed in the stack room.

Still to be done.

The trustees will be replacing the old blinds and purchasing new runners for the floor. The Historical Association will make new window treatments for the upstairs. One window sill needs work, the toilet checked out, and the hot water heater turned on.

Once all the storage items are unpacked, the downstairs will again be ready for business. The Historical Association will then begin soliciting for items to be added or loaned to the museum for display and regular hours can be established.
